Tan Case: Instructions & Tips

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- Use a copy of your worksheet and the Tan Case
- Start with the Nature of Abuse factors
- Responsivity factors – code what you can or consider your area.
 - Management: consider your area
- Appoint a facilitator to keep you moving
- Identify only one or two possible scenarios & Call me in to get started if you need.

Steps 2 & 3: Presence and Relevance of Risk Factors Determine the presence of risk factors (Past and Recent), as well as their relevance to the development of future management strategies (Future)	
Nature of Abuse	Coding
N1. Neglect	Presence: Past ☐ Y ☐ P ☐ N ☐ O Presence: Recent ☐ Y ☐ P ☐ N ☐ O
N2. Emotional Abuse	Presence: Past ☐ Y ☐ P ☐ N ☐ O Presence: Recent ☐ Y ☐ P ☐ N ☐ O

- Reminders:
 - Omit only when there is a lack of information to make a judgement (e.g., evidence not asked or collected).
 - No evidence present = No
 - Y = 'yes' or present, P = 'possibly or partially present', N = 'no' no evidence present, O = 'omit'
 - Recent is the last 4 weeks, Past is prior to the last 4 weeks
